- New Customizable Tool called "Registration"
 - Registration, as for PAC'05, but
 - May also be developed by individual conferences for other activities not part of "GPL" "official" SPMS ...
- Does this Tool correspond to the requirements of JACoW Collaboration Conferences as a whole?







SPMS Philosophy

- Use same data driven philosophy as for the Scientific Programme
- Build customized Registration Forms (via parameter lists) for example through the assembly of interfaces relating to one, several or all activities
 - Combine several activities into one Form
 - Opt for several forms
- Registration, budget handling, accommodation, etc. to be handled via tables ...







Modular Form

- Participation in the Conference (registration of delegates, logistics, payments, list of participants, badges, overall financial management)
- Participation in Social Events (logistics, payments)
- Participation in Excursions (logistics, payments)
- Accommodation (hotel accommodation requirements, payments)

- Registrant (with fee)
- Registrant (fee waived)
- Retiree Registrant
- Student Registrant

Type of Registration

- Early Registration
- Late Registration
- Retiree Registration
- Student Registration







Tables

Social Events:

- Banquet
- Reception
- Outing
- Tour

Fees:

- Early Fee amount
- Late Fee amount
- 1-day Fee amount
- Reduced Fee amount
- Student Fee amount







Statistics as for Scientific Programme

Running totals

- Number of Registrants by Type
- Number of Registrants by Fee
 - Number Type a Delegate @ fee = n amount paid/due
 - Number Type b Delegate @ fee = n amount paid/due
- Number attending Banquet
 - Number Delegates @ fee = n amount paid/due
 - Number Accompanying Persons @ fee = n amount paid/due
 - Number Vendors @ fee = n amount paid/due







Advantages

- Programming is done only once
- Same tool for every type of conference
- Etc.
