

The New Polarized Beam Injection at MAMI,
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Institut Fuer Physik, Universitaet Mainz - A new, very
compact set-up for the injection of the polarized beam at
MAMI has been realized in the last two years. The new
injection does not require the integration of a spin-rotator.
Longitudinal polarization at the experiments is achieved by
adjusting the accelerator energy, which results in an
additional spin rotation of 3.9 degree for a relative change
of the MAMI-energy of $10E-4$. As a result of the shorter
injection we need less beam start-up time and achieve much
higher long term stability. The emittance at the injection
point has been reduced by 50%.

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
