- Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the in-person conference was postponed one


NUMBERS

The end result was a virtual conference on July 26-29, 2021. The virtual conference was held on the Whova virtual conference platform.






- 22 exhibitors

- JACoW SPMS (proceedings)
 - For abstract, paper, poster, oral slides, and presentation video submissions for publishing JACoW proceedings
- Cvent (website and registration)
 - MEDSI2020 main website and registration & payment system
- Whova (virtual conference platform)
 - Nice platform to organize oral, poster, and industrial exhibitions all in one place, easy to navigate
 - Posters have pre-recorded short videos plus live stream
 - Exhibition includes photos, videos, and live stream


LEARNING EXPERIENCE FOR ALL

- Moving from in-person to virtual brought many challenges.
- Computers and software for remote editors were not straightforward. Argonne uses individual licenses for Microsoft and Acrobat, so this added a complication for remote editing for non-Argonne employee(s).
- Submission deadlines were extended several times, and the whole process took longer than originally anticipated.
- MEDSI is fairly new to JACoW (2016), so many authors are still learning to use the SPMS submission process and the document template.
